


RELIGIOUS EDUCATION CURRICULUM

Junior High Students (Grades 6, 7 and 8) meet Monday evenings from 7:15 PM to 8:30 PM.

Grades K thru 5 students meet Wednesday afternoons from 3:40 to 5 PM.



- Kindergarten...Students will be helped to see God's love in all creation.
- Grade 1...Students focus on the theme of the Holy Trinity. 



- Grade 2...Students prepare for the reception of the Sacrament of Reconciliation and the Sacrament of Eucharist.

- Grade 3...The Church is the main point of study; traditions, the Apostles' Creed, the Ten Commandments.



- Grade 4...Morality is the main focus for students; the Beatitudes, in depth study of the Sacrament of Reconciliation.

- Grade 5...The focus for this grade level is the Seven Sacraments.



- Grade 6...The Old Testament is the basis for the sixth grade curriculum; additionally, a review of the Seven Sacraments in light of Hebrew Scripture.

- Grade 7...Throughout the academic year students will focus on the Story of Jesus, His birth thru the Early Church: People of Pentecost.



- Grade 8...This year is devoted to preparation of the Sacrament of Confirmation. Students use the following materials: "Our Church Yesterday and Today", "The Question of Morality", Confirmation textbook, and 'Catholic Memory' Fact/Question Sheets.
